SHRP2 Education Connection Award

We would like to recognize Dr. EunSu Lee for being awarded the SHRP2 Education Connection Award for North Dakota State University - Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute.



The second Strategic Highway Research Program (SHRP2) Education Connection initiative is designed to help academia incorporate SHRP2 Solutions into existing transportation curricula. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) are pleased to announce 10 universities as recipients of SHRP2 Education Connection cooperative agreements. Each university will incorporate one or more SHRP2 products into its current lesson plans. NDSU/UGPTI will be awarded the following SHRP2 products.

Incorporating Reliability Performance Measures in Operations and Planning

Modeling Tools (L04): The emphasis in Project L04 was on improving traffic operations and planning models to reflect travel time reliability and generate travel time reliability as a model output. Phases I and II focused on incorporating travel time reliability in such models. Phase III considered ways to account for the feedback between travel demand and traffic conditions on the network, such as traffic impedances including the variability of travel time.

The objectives of this project were to develop the capability of producing measures of reliability performance as output in traffic simulation models and planning models, and determine how travel demand forecasting models can use reliability measures to produce revised estimates of travel patterns.

Reliability Archive: The SHRP 2 Reliability Archive is a repository that stores the rich data and information from SHRP 2 Reliability and Reliability-related projects. These projects produce various resources, e.g., raw datasets, analysis results, tools and models, and documentation.
