 - Represents approximately 200 for-hire bulk highway carriers and 300 suppliers
 - Transporting hazardous cargoes, food products, and dry bulk



NTTC MEMBERS OPERATE

- More than 26,000 chemical trailers
- Approximately 2,200 compressed gas trailers
- More than 10,000 petroleum delivery trailers
- Almost 10,000 dry bulk trailers
- Approximately 6,600 "non-spec" trailers

 - Driver training and credentials CDL TT HM TWIC
 - Carrier registered for HM and HM Permit
 - Proper Insurance (\$5 million for certain HM)
 - Security program
 - Cleaning quality program

NORTHPORT - Crews are having some difficulties removing a semi-truck that rolled over on Highway 25 three miles south of Northport early Friday morning.


The accident happened at 5 a.m. as the truck, carrying nitrogen, crashed and leaked the nitrogen onto
