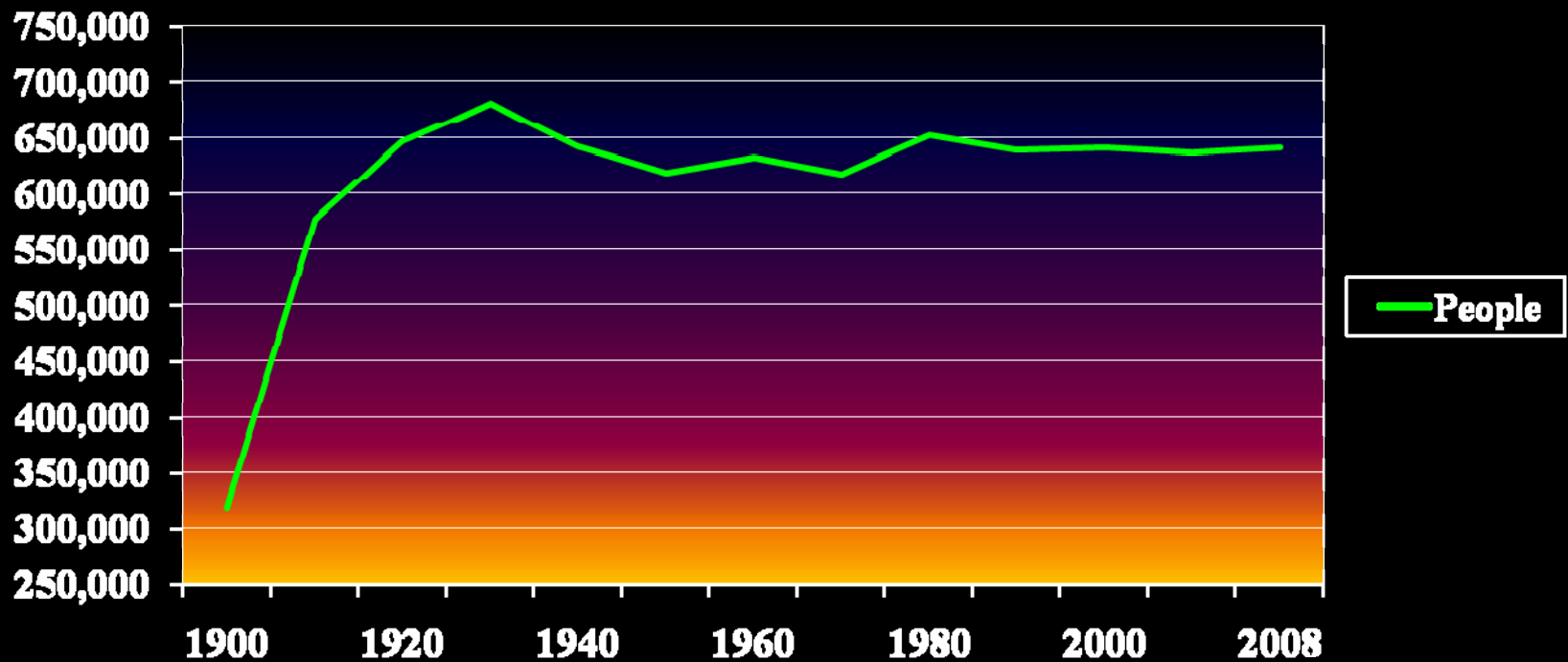
97 Fatal Crashes in 2008

 - 12 City Streets



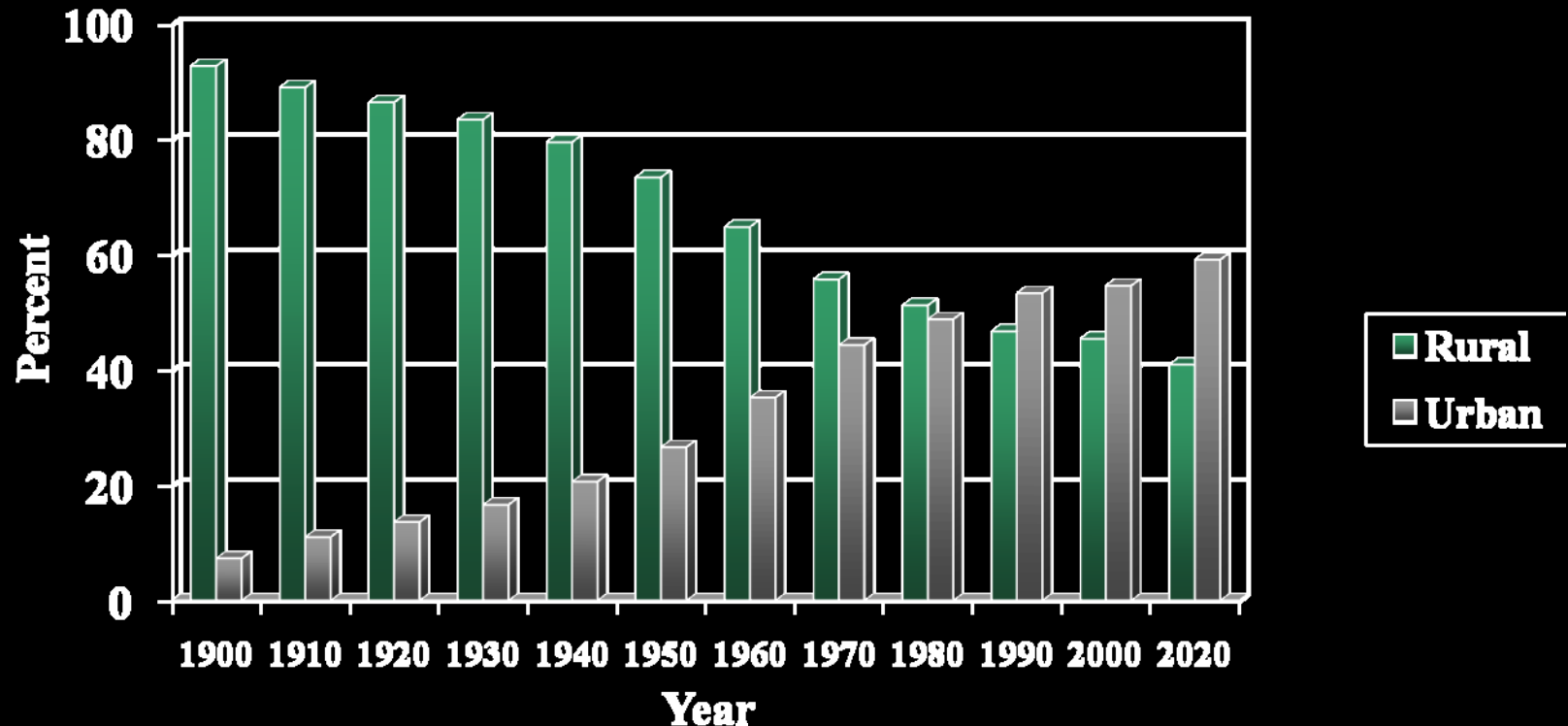
Historical Demographics

ND Population: 1910 - 2008



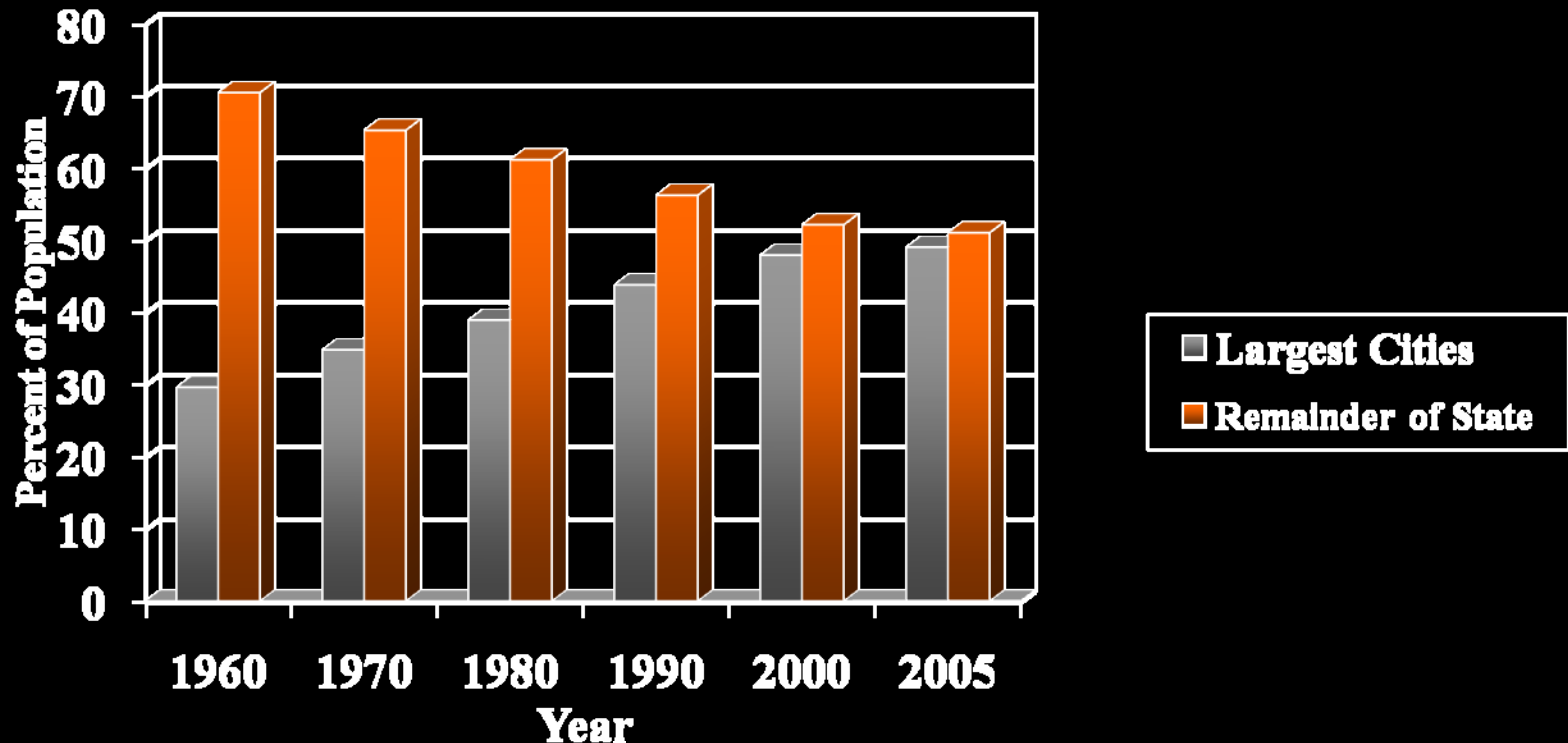
ND Rural-Urban Population Distribution 1900-2020

North Dakota's Eight Largest Cities

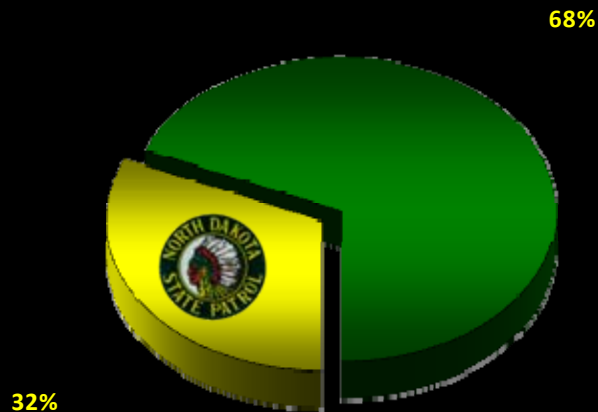

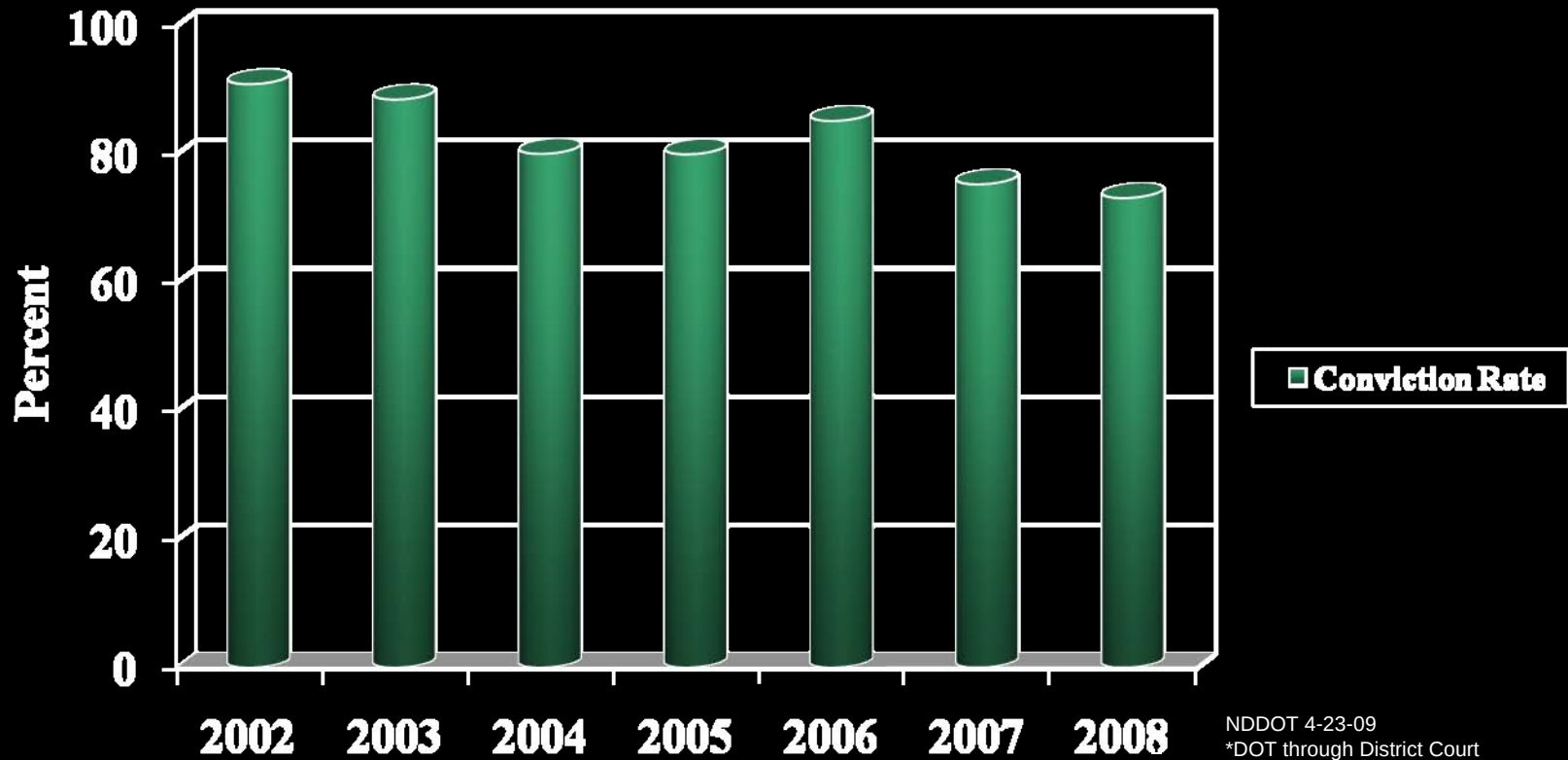
North Dakota DUI Arrests
