## Early attempts

- **2012** — Arizona legislature introduces HB 2679, but bill fails to move forward.
- **2013** — Another bill related to autonomous vehicle testing is introduced. Again, it doesn't move forward...



- **2015** — Governor Doug Ducey signs executive order outlining Arizona's process for the safe development and testing of autonomous and connected vehicle technologies.
- **2018** — In March, the Governor issues an executive order to reflect advancements in technology and testing. In October, he issues an executive order to create the Institute for Automated Mobility.
