Passive Collection

- **Crash/Enforcement Data**

(what occurred)

- Time of Day/Day of Week
- Severity
- Weather Conditions
- Causative Factors, i.e. Alcohol
- Location/area
 - street, county, region, state
- Crash Frequencies
- Historical

Active Collection

- **Roadside Data Collector**

(what is happening)

- Traffic Volume
 - Time of Day/Day of Week
- Direction
- Speeds
 - Mean/Median/Mode
- Variables, i.e. presence of patrol vehicle

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
CMV-Involved Crashes 2019-2020

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

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Crash Severity and roadways with most accidents in 2019 and 2020.



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

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Heat Map indicating where crashes have occurred in 2019 and 2020.



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
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Segment of day and day of week of crashes in 2019 and 2020.



Area Chart of crashes by month in 2019 and 2020.

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

Median MPH per Hour






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
