





53% above the average


77% increase over last year

What is the Cause?


Causal factors closely mirror all crashes

No significant differences between CMV-involved crashes and CMV-caused




I-70 Causal Factors






Lane Violations

CMV-Caused Lane Violation Crashes by Road Condition




Lane Violations...then what?
