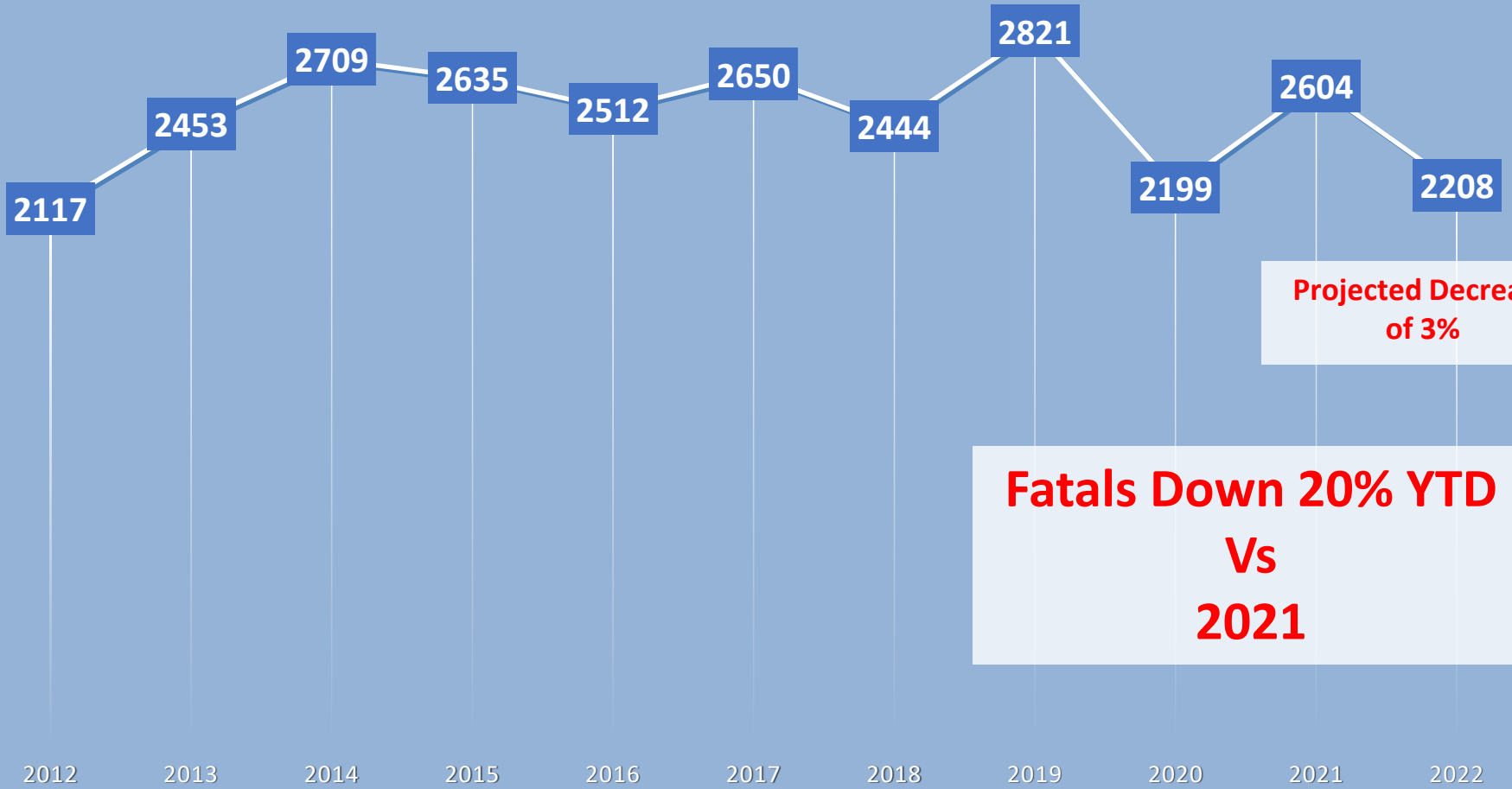

CMV-INVOLVED CRASHES

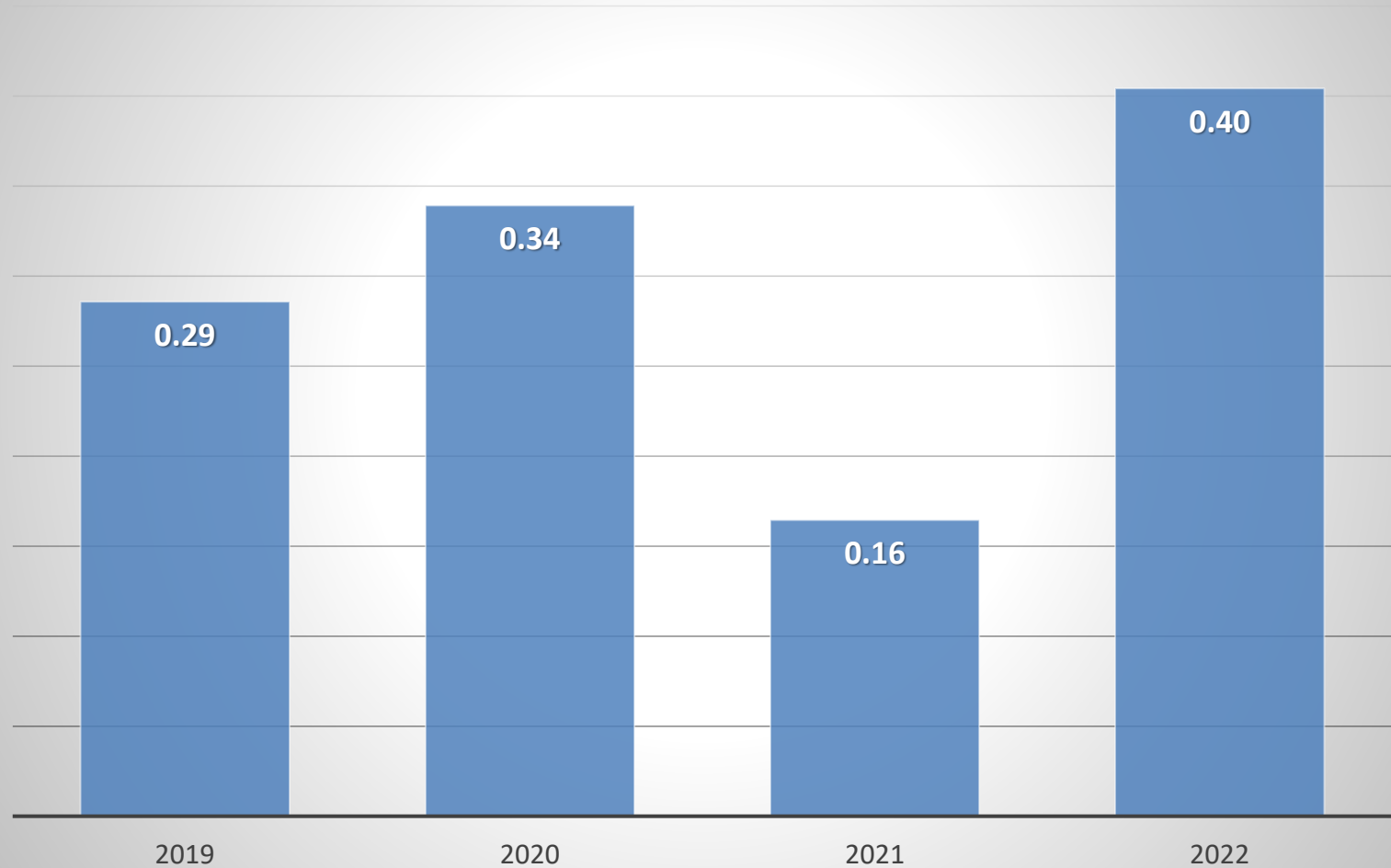

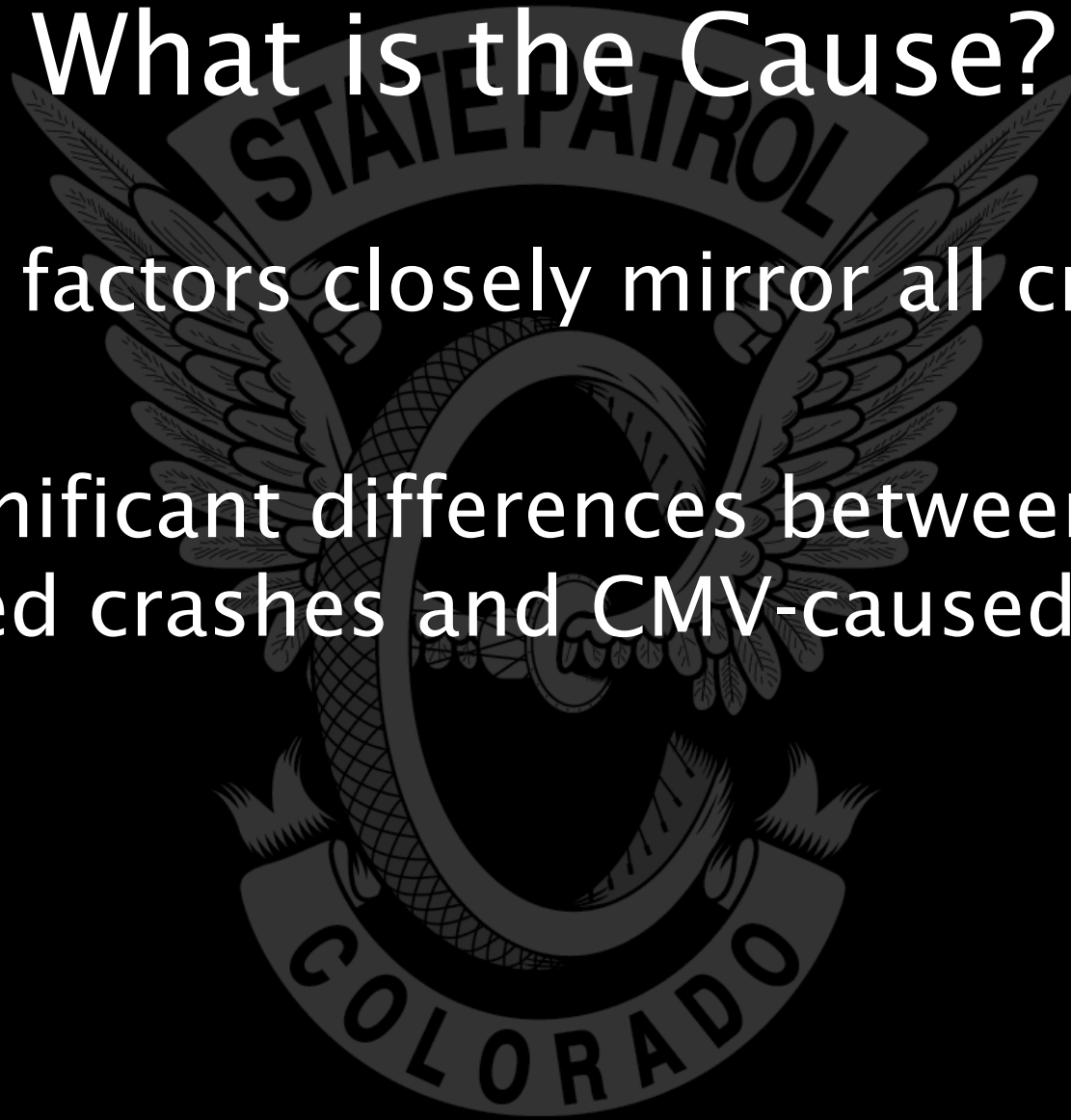

What is the Cause?

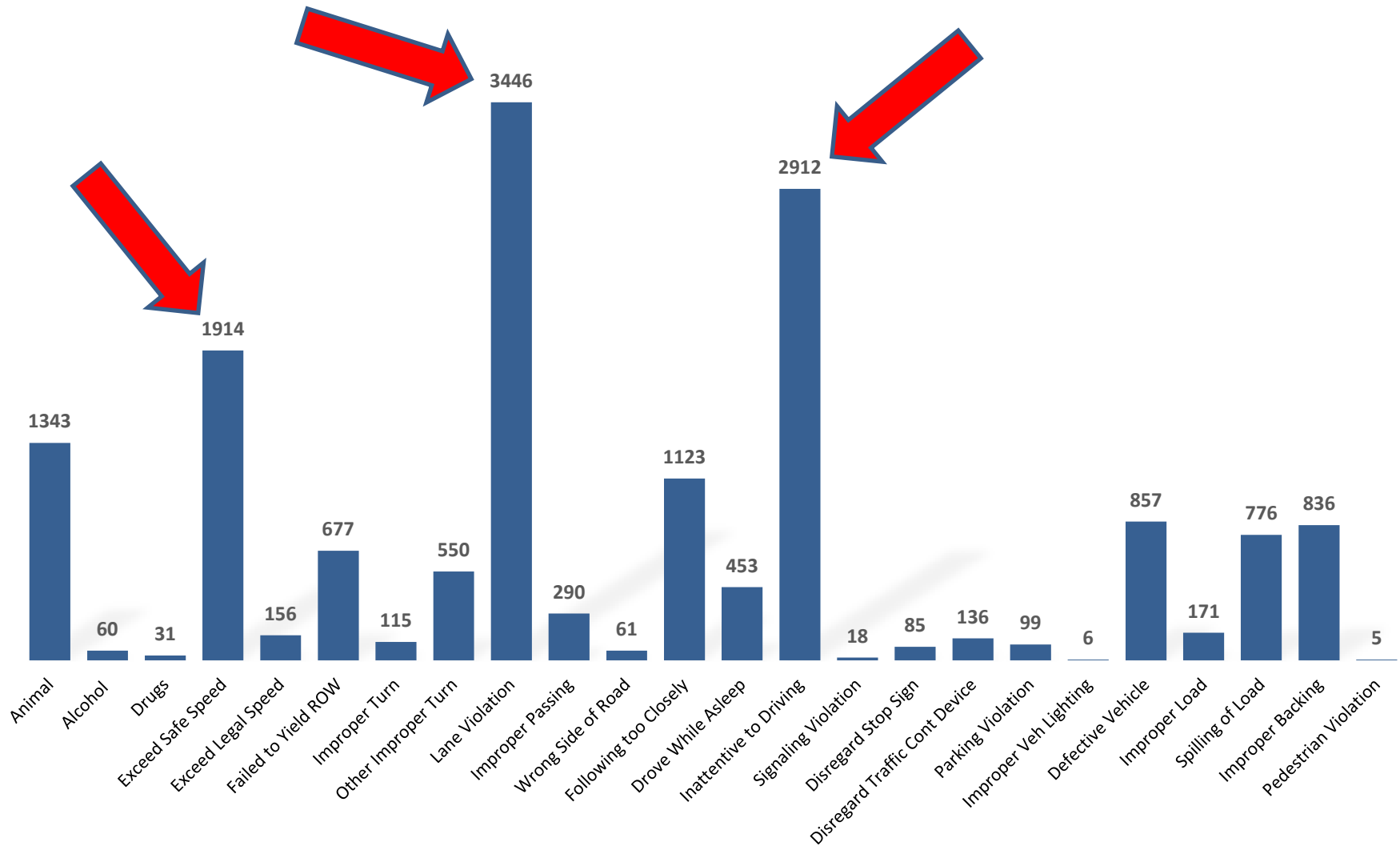
Causal factors closely mirror all crashes

No significant differences between CMV-involved crashes and CMV-caused



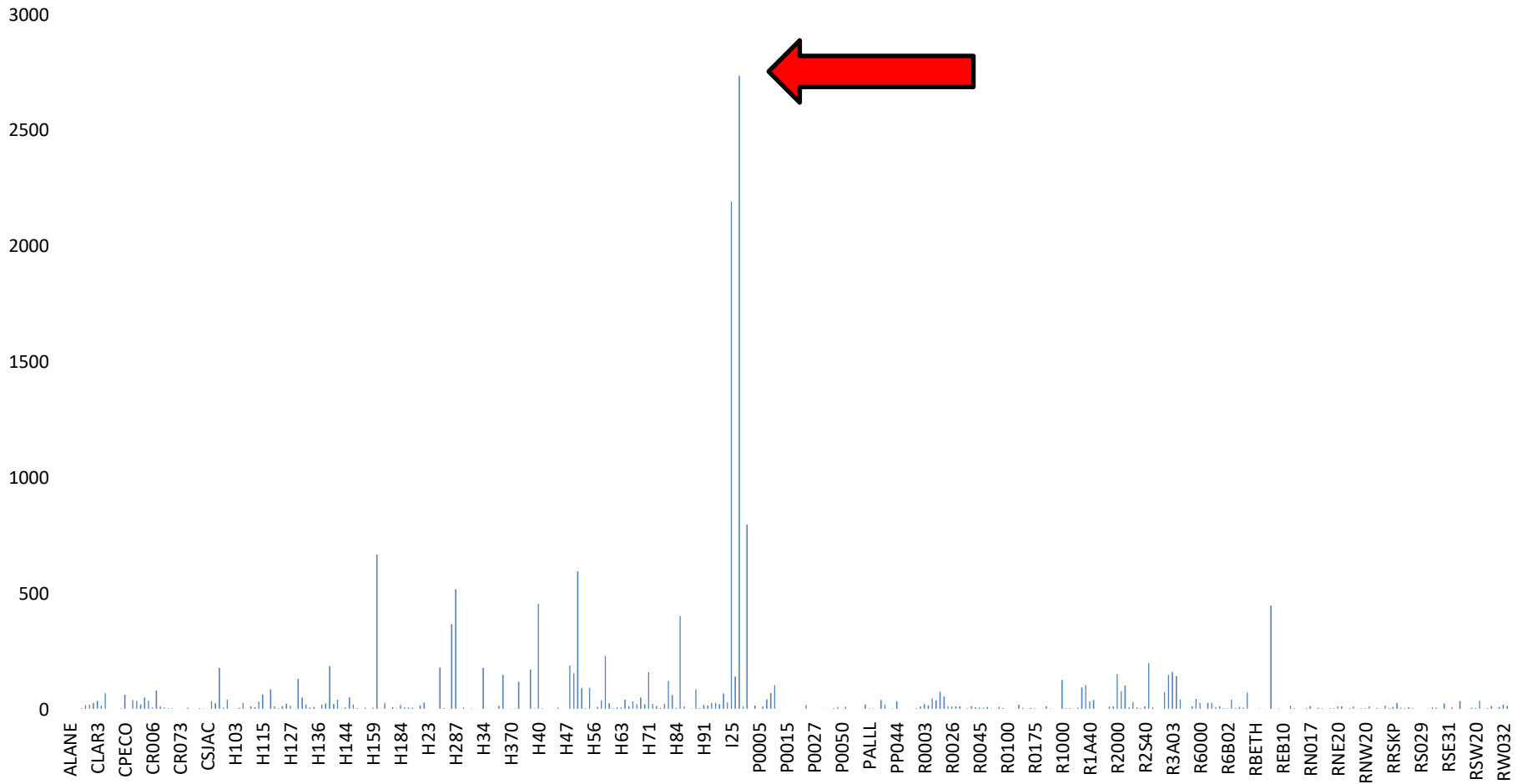

Causal Factors - CMV-Caused



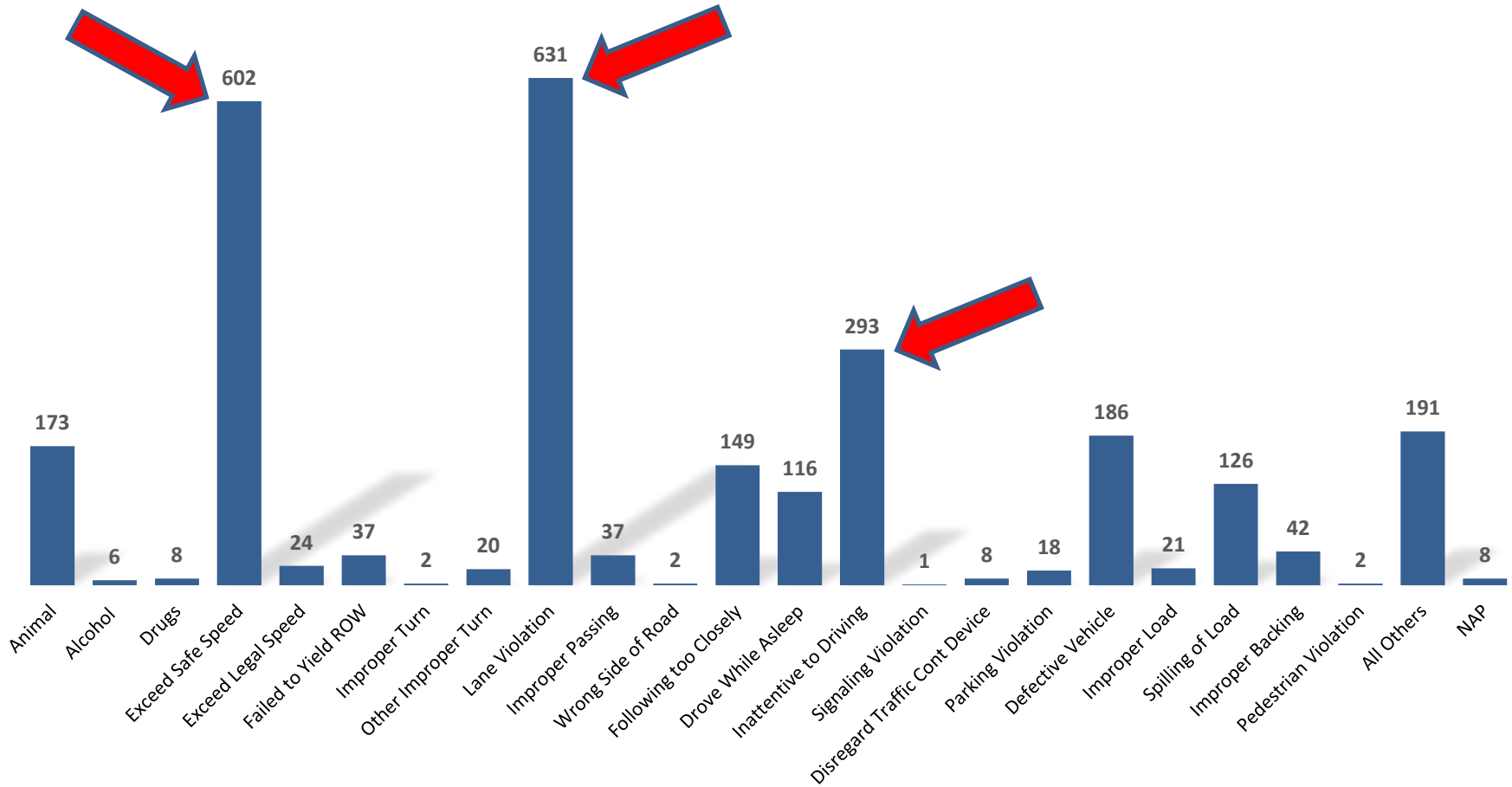

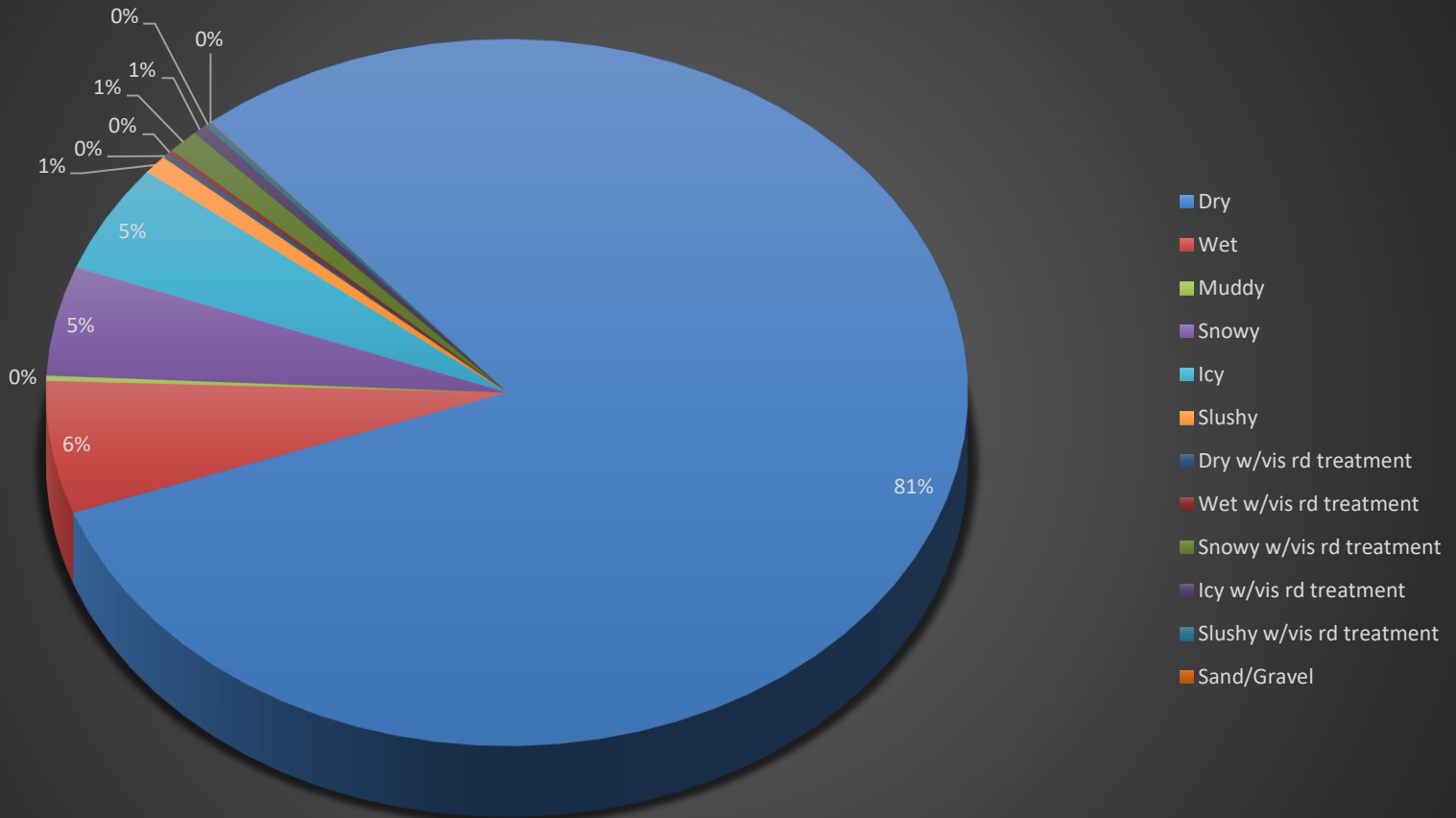

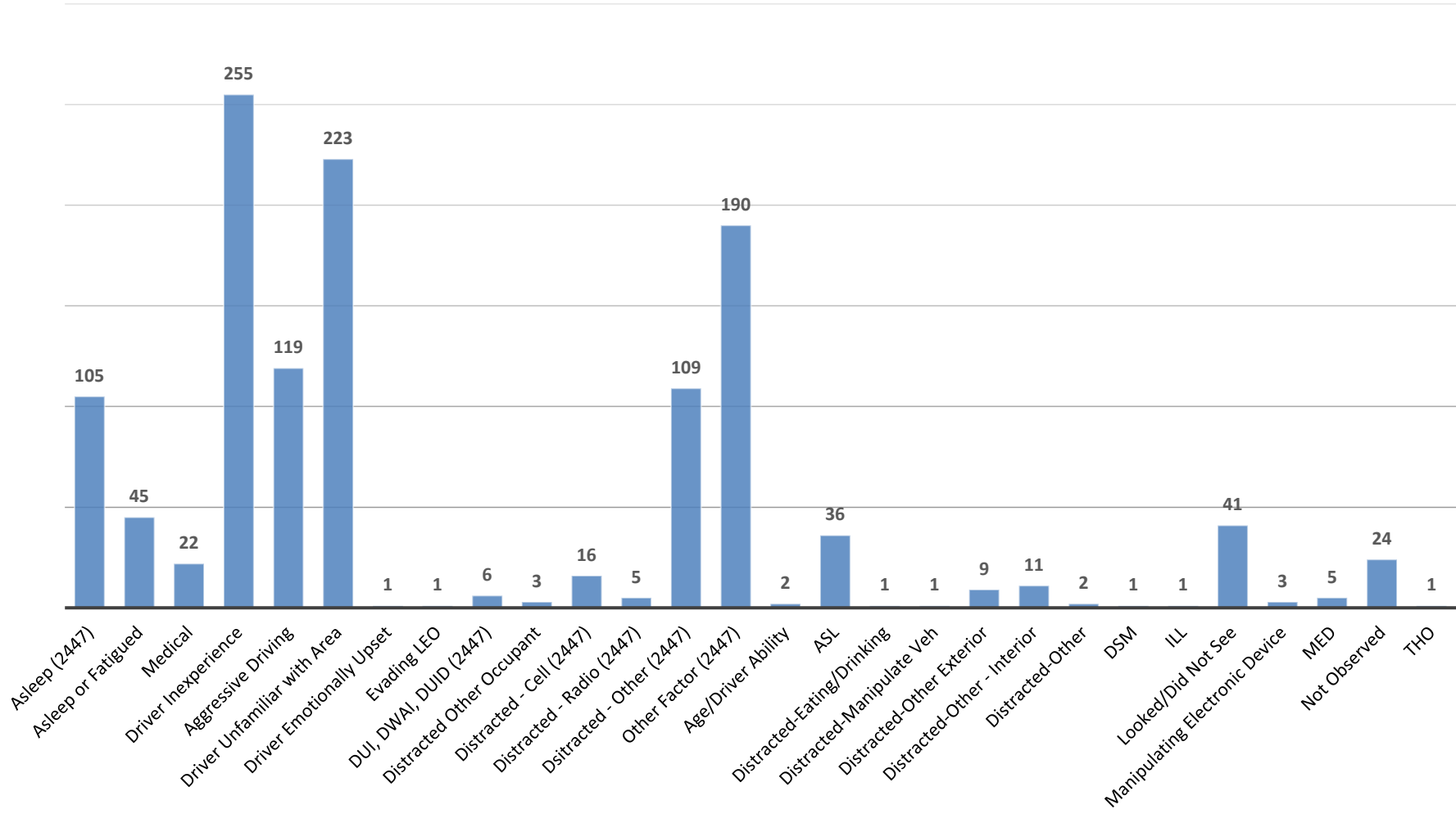

CMV-Caused Lane Violation Crashes by Road Condition



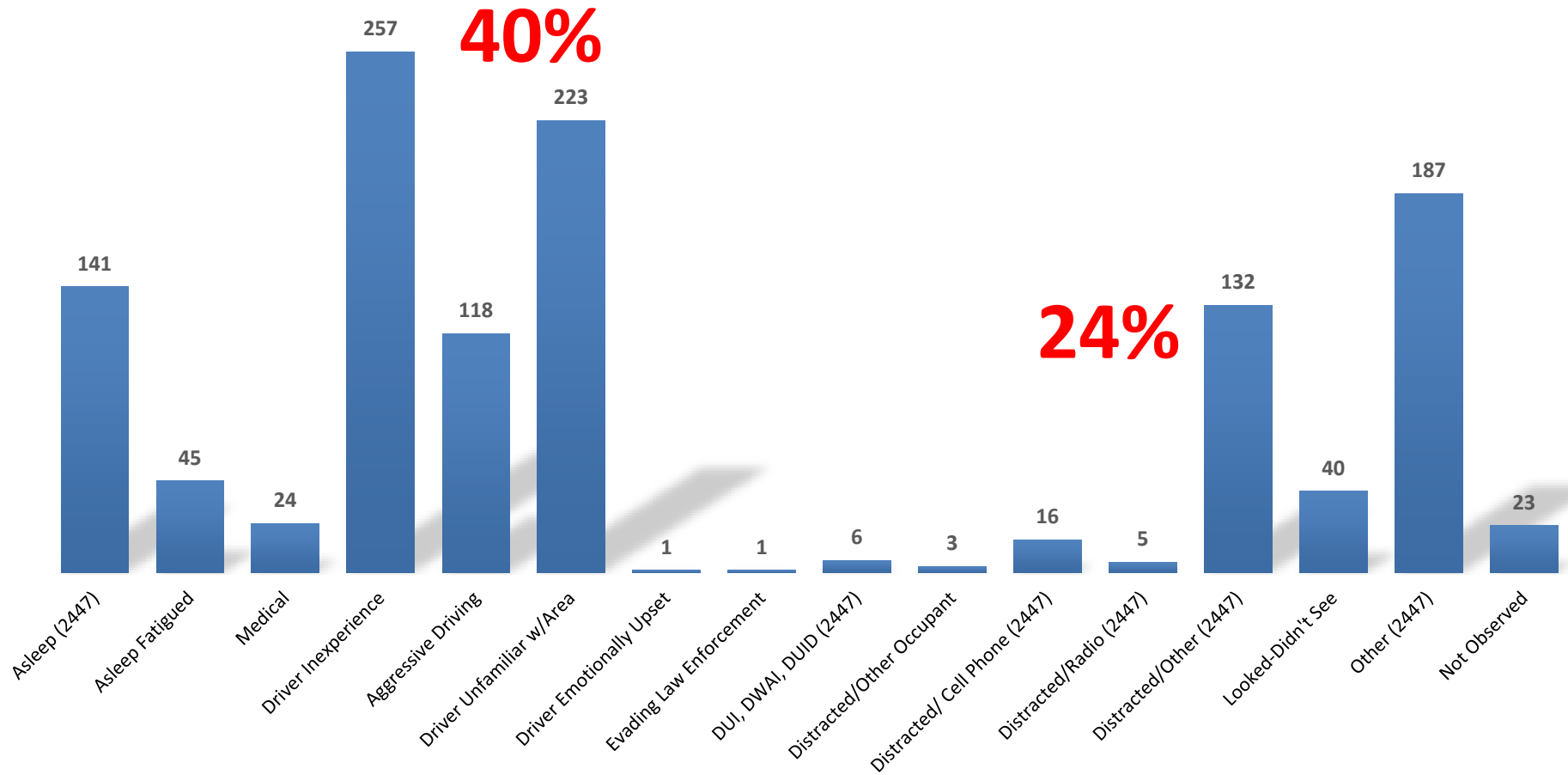
