

# CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS | \$2B

- \$155M for Hwy 85 construction from Hwy 200 north to Long-X
- \$6.9M Increase in District Contractor Payments
- Funding to match all federal formula and grant dollars




# GRANTS | \$116.4M




## OTHER ITEMS

- No Gas Tax Increase
- 25% of Motor Vehicle Excise Tax into the Highway Tax Dist. Fund
- 30% of Legacy Earning Fund into the Highway Fund
- Following the completion of the bidding process for the US 85 segment north of I-94, prepare an Environmental Impact Statement to support the construction of a four-lane highway on the remaining sections specifically from the South Dakota border to I-94 and from Williston to the Montana border.
- HB 1298 | Increased Speed Limits Increases the speed limit to 80 mph on interstate. Speed will be reduced in some areas.


# HIGHWAY TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND \$605.8M



## OIL-PRODUCING COUNTIES


## SB 2012

# PRAIRIE DOG FUNDING | \$160M

- \$40M to non-oil cities (Treasurer Admin)
- \$40M to non-oil counties & townships (Treasurer Admin)
- \$40M to non-oil cities (DOT Admin)
- \$40M to non-oil counties & townships (DOT Admin)



## FLEXIBLE TRANSPORTATION FUND | \$230M

Improve transportation infrastructure on and off the state highway system, including within townships, cities & counties.

- 25% (\$87.5M) Motor Vehicle Excise Tax and \$142.5M SIIF Funds
  - 21% (\$48.3M) to NDDOT for projects on and off the state system
  - 19.5% (\$44.85M) to non-oil counties & cities for projects (NDDOT Admin)
  - 13.5% (\$31.1M) to non-oil townships for projects (NDDOT Admin)
  - 17.5% (\$40.25M) for local bridge projects (NDDOT Admin)
  - 9% (\$20.7M) to non-oil townships by formula distribution (Treasurer Admin)
  - 19.5% (\$44.85M) to non-oil counties & cities by formula distribution (*Treasurer Admin*)


