



Themes and Takeaways

Suggestions for Improvement

- Larger signage with brighter colors
- Requests for shelters at stops
- Improved sign placement for better visibility and accessibility
- Feedback for clearer mapping features in the mobile app

Interest in Car-Sharing

- 61% were unfamiliar with car-sharing
- 57% expressed an interest and willingness to learn more


