CHAPTER 1

OVERVIEW

This bibliography was developed as part of the research project, *The Effect of Federal and State Laws on Rail Labor and the Rail Industry: A National Transportation Policy Challenge*. This work is a multi-disciplinary study of the legal, management, sociological, and economic issues about rail labor relations. The overall objective of this project is to develop and evaluate alternatives to the present federal rail labor laws. To accomplish this objective, changes in rail labor policies that offer the most potential for meaningful negotiation between rail labor and management are identified. Consequently, an understanding of the current policies and their effect upon rail managements' performance, workers' job satisfaction, economic efficiency, and service levels to shippers is essential.

This bibliography was developed from four main sources. First, a Dialog search of several data bases was conducted for material since 1980. Second, earlier cites were gleaned from the bibliography developed by Morris.¹ Third, complementary material was identified from McCabe's bibliography.² Finally, popular and trade journals were reviewed by Ann Schwabe-Neumayer.

The bibliography is organized into four chapters. Chapters 2 and 4 include articles from academic journals, books, dissertations, and technical reports. Chapters 3 and 5 have articles from popular and trade journals. Chapters 2 and 3 are organized by subject matter. The structure for both chapters is:

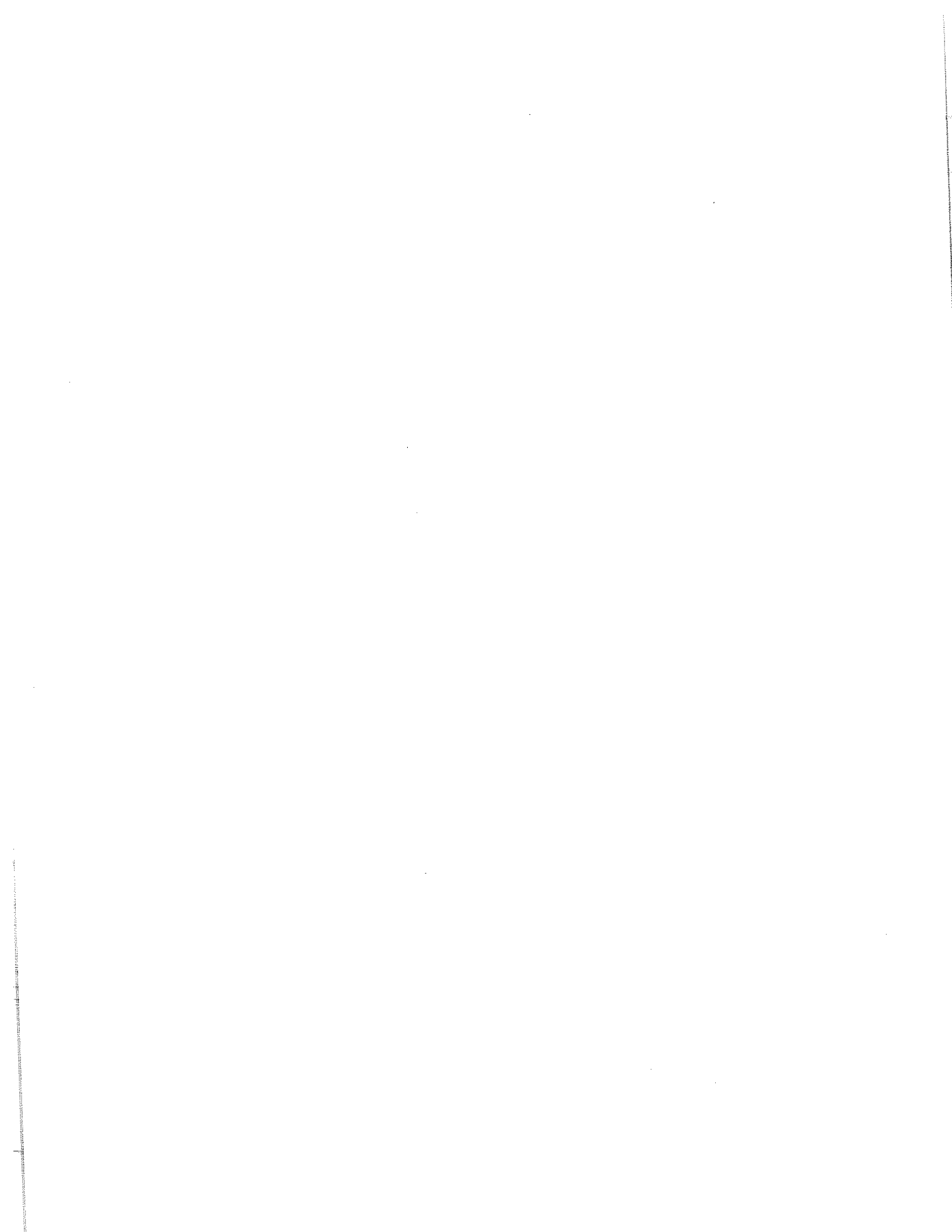
