# **Meeting Minutes**

## 1. Member roll – 14 participants

## 2. 2022 ACS60 events (meetings, workshops, podium session, and paper session)

- a. Sunday: All the committees were told that they could put on workshops. We were invited to participate in one on Sunday regarding Making Safe Systems a Reality: Planning to Implementation.
  - i. We have a small role specific to safe systems in truck and bus safety focusing on a systemic approach, not a vehicle centric approach.
  - ii. Bob will moderate the breakout session.
- b. Monday: Three subcommittee meetings. We will have facilitators for these meetings for those subcommittee chairs who cannot make it. Poster session at 1:30.
- c. Tuesday: Two subcommittee meetings.
- d. Wednesday: Full committee meeting which ends at noon. Lectern session that afternoon on Large Truck Safety Performance. Mouyid Islam will moderate the Lectern Session
- e. Thursday: Another workshop on Thursday concerning Traffic Law Enforcement at a Crossroads: How Can Research Help.
  - i. We have a presenter to focus on the crisis on law enforcement without opening it up to tough or negative issues that may cause hurt feelings. This will only focus on the data side of Law enforcement. The moderators are very capable people who will be watching out for these side issues.
